



Karting Legends Membership process and members commitment to the club

Karting Legends has a limited number of members and therefore expects members to attend as many meetings as possible and participate in activities whenever possible. The process of membership is that if the applicant and kart information pass the criteria for membership the applicant would be invited to a meeting. Participation in that meeting would be allowed if kart and equipment meet requirements. After the meeting the applicant would have the initial probationary membership confirmed or refused. If acceptable there would be a further probationary period of a year.

Karting Legends members have a commitment to the club and a number of actions are expected from members and probationary members. The commitments and requirements are:-

1. Read, digest and sign (prospective members prior to any demonstration) the Drivers Code of Conduct which is to be adhered too when demonstrating the kart together with the information given at the Drivers briefing.
2. Read and digest any documents sent out to members generally for their safety particularly the Final Instructions issued before any meeting.
3. Generally attendance at a display / demonstration is for the duration of the event and to also to assist in the dismantling of awnings when the display is finished approx 4 / 4.30 on the final day.
4. Only black chairs with the Karting Legends logo are to be used in the awning display area.
5. Wear attire available from the club at cost price displaying Karting Legends and the logo during the displays. (Required after 1st year of membership).
6. Awnings used for the displays are provided by the members and members are generally expected to have an awning which they can use. The awning needs to match the awnings being used by the club which are currently supplied by Surf & Turf. Awnings provided by members need to be black with the canopy showing Karting Legends and logo. The model from Surf and Turf is the 3m x3m Canopro Lite Lightweight Gazebo complete package with side sheets and canopy. (Required after 1st year of membership).
7. Kart should be brought to any meeting fully prepared ready for scrutineering and in a pristine condition ready for display and demonstration. Fuelling and tyre checking shall be done in a designated area (not the display area).
8. MSUK Karting Clubman (UK Only) licence is the minimum licence required by the Club and needs to be in place before any track demonstration.
9. For information all karts must have an easy starting procedure, either by electric starter (preferred) and / or a designated person to assist, such a person can only be responsible for the assistance of starting one kart.
10. Paddock space is normally very limited at events so vehicles / vans / trailers / caravans over 7m may be requested to find space away from the display area.
